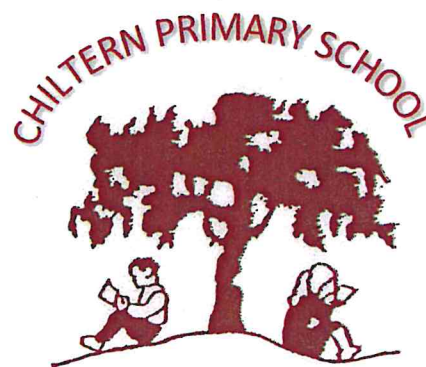

Uniform Policy

The school uniform policy links with behaviour, discipline and assertive mentoring.

The uniform colours are claret (a shade of burgundy), white and grey.

- Sweatshirts and cardigans are claret and PE shorts are maroon
- Polo shirts and t-shirts are white
- Skirts, trousers and pinafore dresses are grey
- Summer dresses are red and white check

Children should come to school wearing their PE kit ensuring that school colours are worn and shorts are mid-thigh to knee length. Tops must also be full length (no cropped tops).

In support of making uniform affordable, we are happy for school uniform without logos to be worn, providing they are in the correct school colours, as detailed above. These are available from many local supermarkets. Uniform with logos can be purchased from:

Children should be dressed as follows:

Boys	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● White polo shirt – logo optional ● Claret sweatshirt – logo optional ● Grey trousers – long or short ● Sensible black shoes or black fitted trainers
Girls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● White polo shirt – logo optional ● Claret sweatshirt or cardigan – logo optional ● Grey skirt, trousers or pinafore dress – skirts and dresses should be at least mid-thigh to knee length ● Sensible black shoes, black fitted trainers or ankle boots in winter ● In summer, girls may wear red and white gingham dresses with school sweatshirt or cardigan
Bags	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A book bag or rucksack can be used. Please avoid large bags as space in cloakrooms and lockers is limited
PE (all pupils)	<p>Indoor PE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● White t-shirt with optional logo ● Maroon shorts (must be mid-thigh to knee length) ● Plimsolls <p>Outdoor PE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● White t-shirt with optional logo ● Black, maroon or grey jogging bottoms ● Black, maroon or grey sweatshirts ● Change of socks ● Black or white trainers (not astro turf trainers)
Arts & crafts	<p>All children should have adequate protection for their clothes. Art coveralls are provided by the school in Reception and Year 1. From year 2 onwards, parents should provide a coverall or other protection such as an old shirt worn back to front with elasticated cuffs.</p>
Sun protection	<p>As our playground gets very sunny during hot weather, we encourage pupils to wear sun hats and to apply a high factor sun cream before coming to school.</p>
