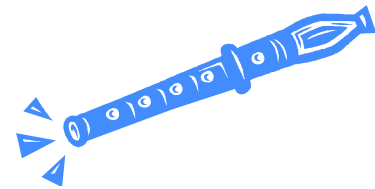
We offer year 2 children the opportunity to be taught to play the recorder by a professional music teacher from the Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts Trust. The music teacher will take a group of 10 children for 30 minutes a week on Mondays (during the school day). Lessons will start on Monday 19 September.

There will be 3 sets of 10 lessons throughout the year as follows:

September to November

January to March

April to June



The charge for 10 lessons is £30.00 (payable in advance) including the loan of a recorder.

Places are offered on a first come, first served basis. If your child would like to take lessons, please pay for these on Parent Pay. If your payment is successful it means your child has a place as once all the places have been taken, you will no longer be able to purchase this service. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium and you wish to use this for lessons, please contact the school office.

YEAR 2 RECORDER GROUP – NOTES FOR PARENTS

- *The charge is £30.00 for 10 lessons.*
- *Recorders are loaned to pupils free of charge and it is the responsibility of the parent and child that they are looked after.*
- *Recorders should be returned to the school at the end of the lessons in good condition.*
- *Lost or broken recorders will be replaced by parents.*
- *Pupils may bring their own recorders if wished provided they are the correct type, ie descant. They should be named.*
- *Payment is made via ParentPay and once all the places are filled payment will not be possible.*
- *Pupils are expected to practice regularly at home*
- *Pupils are expected to attend for all the lessons*
- *Payment is non-returnable.*
- *If the music teacher cannot attend at any time, she will re-schedule the lesson to ensure that all lessons are given.*
- *A register is kept weekly.*
- *Music teachers endeavour to be flexible should the child be involved in another activity at the time of their lesson.*
- *Learning an instrument is an exciting and valuable experience that can lead to an enjoyable lifelong activity*
