## LUNCHTIME AND BREAK TIMES

Chiltern now has separate Key Stage lunch times and break times with our doubling of pupil numbers.

### **Break Times:**

FS/ KS1 – 10.15am – 10.30am

2.30pm – 2.40pm

KS2 – 10.35am – 10.50am

### **Lunches:**

FS/ KS1 – 11.45am – 12.45pm

KS2 – 12.30pm – 1.25pm.

Our lunchtime lead, along with our classroom TAs, care for our children during these times, serving their meals and supporting play alongside our playtime 'Buddies'. These staff follow our lunch time policy.

Children may bring a healthy packed lunch to school or pay for a hot dinner provided by our caterers - Chartwells. All foundation stage and key stage 1 pupils are entitled to a universal free school meal, funded by central Government.

Our delivered in hot meals should be ordered online every 3 weeks and monies can be paid on Parent Pay (as with all other payments). Menu choices are available online too, catering for all diets and faiths. Please don't hesitate to pop in to see the school office if you are unable to complete your orders or pay

.

We encourage children to drink water throughout the day, but squash or fruit juice may be provided for lunchtimes, or break times if paid for online each term. Please do not send fizzy or sports drinks to school. Our Parent Teacher Association have provided all pupils with a sports top water bottle to ensure they are hydrated for their learning.

Lunchtime clubs are on offer to pupils throughout the week eg Reading/ games/ sports. We are looking to extend the lunch sports beyond 2 days and start chess and reporting clubs.

## **Free School Meals for EYFS, KS1 and KS2**

If you are receiving any of the following benefits (but NOT Working Tax Credit), you are entitled to claim free meals for your children:

---

1. Income Support
2. Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
3. An income related employment and support allowance
4. Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
  
5. Child Tax Credit, provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190. Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop Working Tax Credit
6. Universal Credit
7. The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit.

By registering for free school meals, you will also qualify for additional pupil premium vouchers to aid your child's education. If you need help with any aspect of free school meals, just pop into school to speak to our admin staff.

## **Snacks**

Our youngest children - in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 - are provided with a piece of fruit or vegetable every day.

Our key stage 2 children are encouraged to bring in a piece of fresh fruit for morning break times too.

## **Milk**

Our pupils' morning milk is supplied by "Cool Milk at School". This can be ordered on line. This milk is available free to children under 5 and to those who are entitled to Free School Meals.
